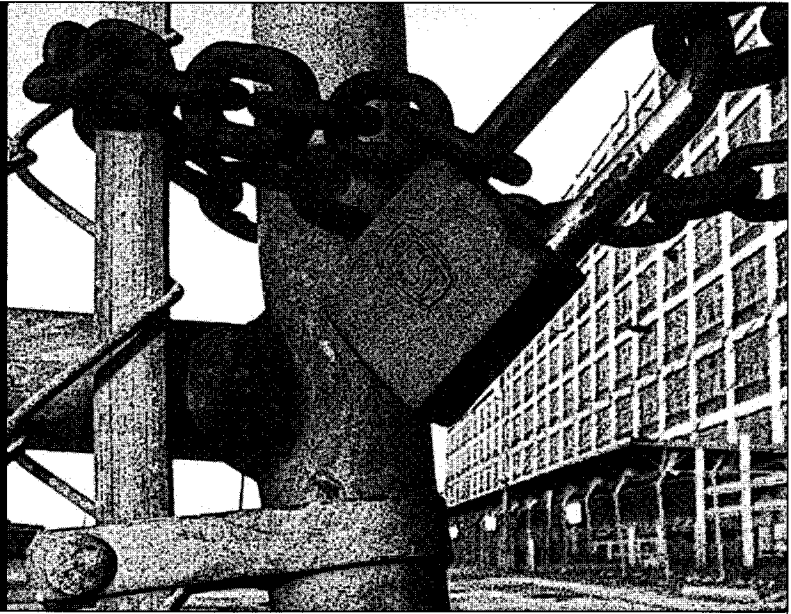


Don't Let John Kasich Export Your Job

VOTED FOR NAFTA

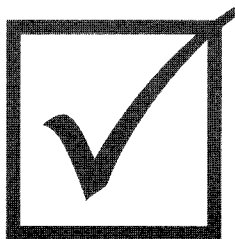

We lost 2.4 million American jobs, including 91,800 jobs in Ohio. (Economic Policy Institute, Briefing Paper #260, 3/23/10; H.R. 4444, Vote 251, 9/19/00)

Kasich proposed eliminating the programs that helped workers whose jobs were shipped overseas because of bad trade deals. (The Washington Times, 5/12/95)
