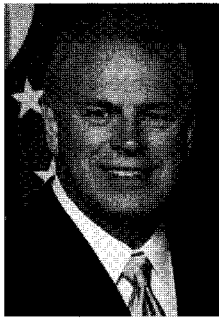

TED STRICKLAND

WALL ST



JOHN KASICH

A managing director at Lehman Brothers for eight years, John Kasich made nearly \$1.4 million in 2008 and reported \$432,200 in bonuses. He has released only a part of one year's tax records and refuses to release more. (Columbus Dispatch, 6/15/10; Cleveland Plain Dealer, 4/29/10)

FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

WORKING FOR MAIN STREET. Ted Strickland balanced the budget in 2009 and has the best approach going forward to clean up the financial mess the Big Banks like Lehman Brothers left behind in Ohio. (Cleveland Leader, 7/11/09; The Washington Post, 9/24/08)

GOOD JOBS

SUPPORTS WORKERS' FREEDOM TO FORM UNIONS. Ted Strickland supports workers' freedom to form unions to bargain for a better life. In fact, he took action to give more Ohioans collective bargaining rights. (Executive Order 235, 7/17/07)

SUPPORTS JOB CUTS, PRIVATIZING AND OUTSOURCING. John Kasich is pushing either to cut or contract out all public service jobs in Ohio, saying, "If it's in the Yellow Pages, outsource it." (Lima News, 3/10/10)

TRADE

OPPOSED UNFAIR TRADE POLICIES. Ted Strickland voted against NAFTA, which sent almost 50,000 Ohio jobs to Canada and Mexico, devastating our state's job market. (H.R. 3450, Vote 575, 11/17/93; Economic Policy Institute Briefing Paper #173, 9/28/06)

SENT OUR JOBS OVERSEAS. John Kasich voted for NAFTA and to open trade with China, which together outsourced more than 141,000 Ohio jobs. (H.R. 3450, Vote 575, 11/17/93; H.R. 4444, Vote 228, 5/24/00; Economic Policy Institute Briefing Paper #173, 9/28/06; EPI Briefing Paper #260, 3/23/10)
