

The College of Mount St. Joseph Teacher Master's Program

The College of Mount St. Joseph will host information sessions for the Teacher Education Apprenticeship Master's (TEAM) programs for **Multicultural Special Education (K-12)**, **Adolescent Young Adult (math and science for grades 7 – 12)**, and **Inclusive Early Childhood (grades preK-3)**. Attendees will meet with the directors and coordinators of the programs, as well as with representatives from Graduate Admissions and Financial Aid.

TEAM MSE provides course work for either an Alternative Education Licensure (AEL) or a 2nd license in Special Education, resulting in a Master's Degree in Education. TEAM AYA also provides AEL course work and a Master's Degree. TEAM IEC provides provisional licensure course work for grades preK-3 and a Master's Degree.

TEAMS MSE and IEC will have cohorts starting in May 2010. The TEAM AYA starts at the beginning of each fall, spring, and summer semester. For more information, you may attend an Information Session, or call the College of Mount St. Joseph Education Division at 513.244.4812.
