CPS along with the Ohio Department of Education is now offering training for teachers who wish to be a Certified Resident Educator Mentor.

Becoming a State Certified Mentor will offer future opportunities for you to:

- Assist new teachers in your building;
- Receive a paid stipend; and
- Gain leadership experience.

Right now you have the opportunity to attend a two day training by the Ohio Department of Education and obtain mentor certification **FREE OF CHARGE!** You will then be qualified to mentor new teachers as they enter your building in the future.

Qualified applicants must possess:

- ❖ Five-year Professional License OR Permanent License or Certificate;
- ❖ Five years of teaching experience; and
- ❖ Recent classroom experience within the last five years.

If interested, you must be available to attend two days of training.

Session 1: Instructional Mentoring, will be available on December 19th or January 7th.

Session 2: Resident Educator 1, will be available on December 20th or January 21st.
