Vote 'NO' on Issue 2 to Repeal SB 5

The repeal of Senate Bill 5—the unfair, unjust and unsafe attack on all of us—will be put before voters as Issue 2 on the Nov. 8 ballot after an unprecedented grass roots movement gathered 1.3 million petition signatures in favor of repeal.

OFT members across the state played a major role in the petition phase, now we must step up our efforts to ensure this unfair law is finally repealed. We must encourage our friends, family, neighbors and others to vote 'NO' on Issue 2 to repeal SB 5.

Why We Should Vote 'NO' on Issue 2

It hurts our families while rewarding special interests.

Politicians talk about shared sacrifice, but those same politicians wrote in a loophole that exempts themselves, upper management and political appointees from this law.

It hurts our communities and schools. The quality of community services will be degraded, with fewer teachers in our classrooms, fewer police on our streets and fewer caseworkers caring for our elderly or aiding children and families in need.

It makes it illegal for teachers and school personnel to negotiate school safety issues. We will lose the right to fight for strong student discipline policies, monitoring systems in hallways, locker rooms and school buses, and the removal of hazardous materials like asbestos.

It makes it illegal for teachers to negotiate issues that affect student learning. We will lose the right to

advocate for smaller class sizes, create special programs for reading, math and science, and protect art, music and athletic programs.
